This Elevate Learning experience consists of a set of questions that are a companion to your class participation and study of the assigned readings. The hope is that working on the responses to these questions throughout the course will help you to deepen your understanding and application of the gospel as you reflect on and share what you have learned. Please complete the following steps for each question:

1. Write an organized response for each question using your own words. Support your answers with the scriptures and the words of the prophets. Be sure your responses are appropriate to share.
2. Review your responses before Dec. 7, 2017.
3. Revise your responses as needed.
4. Submit your final responses in class on or before Dec. 7, 2017.

Your responses should be completed outside class. If you have a specific need, disability, or health-related condition, speak with Brother Woodward so that he can make accommodations to help you complete this experience.

Questions

1. What is the role of the Book of Mormon in your life? What is its role in helping you learn and understand truth? What blessings have you seen, felt, or experienced through your study of the Book of Mormon during this semester? How will your study and application of the Book of Mormon improve, based on your experience in this course?
2. According to the Book of Mormon, how has Christ made it possible for you to be redeemed? How has your understanding of Christ's atonement grown and deepened this semester? According to the teachings and doctrine in the Book of Mormon, how can you accept and fully benefit from Christ's atonement?
3. What truths from the Book of Mormon have influenced you? List three to five principles or doctrines from the Book of Mormon that you have learned or that have become more meaningful to you because of your participation in this course. From your list, choose one principle or doctrine and explain it in depth, using examples from the scriptures and the words of the prophets. Share why this principle or doctrine is important to you and how you will act on it.

Write your testimony of what you have learned through your study of the Book of Mormon during this course (some of this material might be a repeat of some of your responses in questions 1 and 2 above).
